



Gwen Ifill/PBS NewsHour Fellowship

DURATION:	10 weeks (summer)
LOCATION:	Arlington, VA
PAY:	\$13 per hour, plus overtime eligibility

This 10-week PBS NewsHour summer fellowship was created with funding from the Washington Press Club Foundation in honor of Gwen Ifill, the award-winning former PBS NewsHour co-anchor and managing editor and Washington Week moderator and managing editor. Primary responsibilities include research for national, international, and political news stories, gathering editorial information and video elements, covering live events, generating story ideas, producing web content, and other projects/duties as assigned.

Eligibility:

- US Citizen.
- Current undergraduate or graduate student enrolled and in good standing at a college/university as of January 1, 2018.
- Proof of academic achievement in college/university.
- Recipient of need-based financial assistance for college/university education.
- Two letters of recommendation from people familiar with your academic and/or journalism work.
- Autobiographical essay to be no longer than 400 words.
